Jeremy joined Standard Chartered in 1994 and has run businesses for Standard Chartered in Japan (as Country CEO from 1998 – 2000), Hong Kong (as Regional Head of Financial Institutions from 1997 – 1998), Singapore (as Head of Corporate Banking from 1996 – 1997) and London (as Head of European Corporate Banking from 1994 – 1996).

Before moving to Standard Chartered, Jeremy held various senior management positions in ANZ Banking Group, including Country CEO Germany, Managing Director ANZ Securities (Switzerland AG) and Director Capital Markets ANZ Securities HK Ltd.
