Shayne Nelson is the Regional Chief Executive Officer for the Middle East and North Africa region and is responsible for the implementation of the Group's business strategies and overall Corporate Governance for the region. In 2007, Shayne was appointed as Chairman of Islamic Banking Board of Standard Chartered Bank and Chairman for Standard Chartered Bank Pakistan.

Prior to this assignment, Shayne was Chief Executive Officer and Managing Director for Standard Chartered Bank Malaysia Berhad, a wholly owned subsidiary of Standard Chartered Plc. In addition to his role as Chief Executive Officer of Standard Chartered Malaysia, Shayne sat on the board of directors of Cagamas Berhad, the National Mortgage Corporation; the Malaysian Institute of Banks (IBBM), the British Malaysian Chamber of Commerce and was a council member of the Association of Banks in Malaysia (ABM).

Shayne joined Standard Chartered in 1997 as Regional Head of Audit, Corporate & Institutional Banking covering Asia Pacific and India. He was then appointed the Regional Head of Credit for Hong Kong, China and North East Asia before being appointed Chief Risk Officer for Wholesale Bank, which is a global position covering over 50 countries within the Standard Chartered network.

Throughout his career, he has held numerous challenging positions in two of Australia's major banks, Westpac Banking Corporation and the National Australia Bank. His roles in these two banks included periods in corporate finance, debt restructuring and senior positions in retail and wholesale banking.
